ARCHIVAL POLICY

1. Background:

Regulation 30(8) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, mandates framing of a policy by all listed companies for archival of documents.

2. Objective:

The objective of Archival Policy ("Policy") is to comply with Regulation 30(8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as mentioned below:

"The listed entity shall disclose on its website all such events or information which has been disclosed to stock exchange(s) under this regulation, and such disclosures shall be hosted on the website of the listed entity for a minimum period of five years and thereafter as per the archival policy of the listed entity, as disclosed on its website."

3. Policy:

In accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Regulation, the Company shall ensure that all the information shall be hosted on the Company's website (www.mitsuchem.com) for a period of 5 years from the initial posting/hosting. These disclosures may be removed / deleted from the website after expiry of five years from the aforementioned date.

4. Review and Amendments to the Policy:

The Board of Directors can amend this Policy, as and when deemed fit. Any or all provisions of this Policy would be subject to revision / amendment in accordance with the Rules, Regulations, Notifications etc. on the subject as may be issued by relevant statutory authorities, from time to time. In case of any amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc. issued by the relevant authorities are not consistent with the provisions laid down under this Policy, then such amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc. shall prevail upon the provisions hereunder and this Policy shall stand amended accordingly from the effective date as laid down under such amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc.
